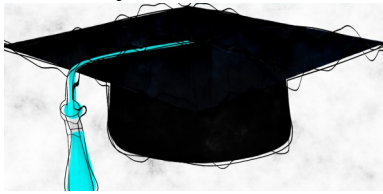

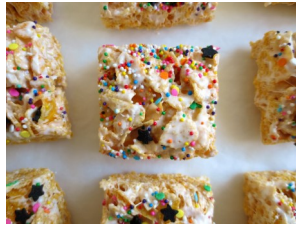

Tiffanie Kouf was named the Huron Chamber and Visitors Bureau's Ambassador of the Year.

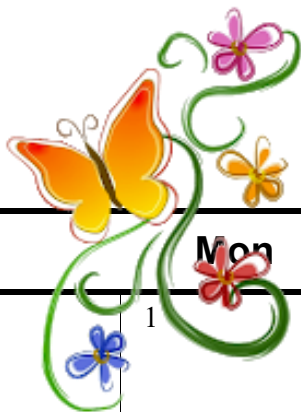
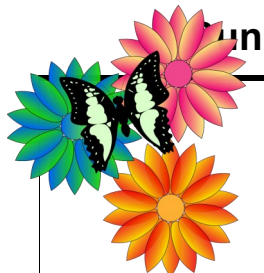
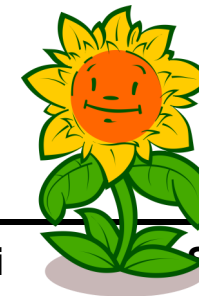
