# THE STORY

Deep down, most of us want the same things from life. Sure, some people like fancy vehicles while others just want to read. Some like indoor plumbing while others want to rough it in the woods. There's plenty of difference in tastes. But at the level of the heart, we're pretty similar: We want meaning. We want joy. We want acceptance. We want life.

We're desperate for a boss to say, "Good job," or a call from our dream date. We want good news about the stock market and our family's health. Yet these are all reverberations of our deepest need: God. But how can we get a word from *God?* Don't look at me! The only person good enough, competent enough, and wise enough to reveal God to you is, well, *God*.



To live well we need a word *from God*, God's Word. I need it. You need it. Following Jesus is challenging, so one day Jesus asked Peter if he really wanted to continue. Peter said, "Lord, to whom shall we go? *You* have the words of eternal life" (Jn 6:68).

Still true today. We *need* God's self-revelation in the Bible. So read *The Story* with me. It's an abridged, chronological Bible that reads a little more like a novel. Experience God's Story – and your own – in a new way this Fall. Each Sunday we'll focus on the next part of *The Story* in worship and there will be various weekly discussion groups.
