

It took a big church fight to get the little phrase, "I believe in the forgiveness of sins" into the Apostles' Creed.

Around the year 300 AD, a general hostile to Christianity took control of the Roman Empire and began persecuting Christfollowers. His soldiers destroyed church-buildings, burned Bibles, and imprisoned the church leadership. But he offered the harried Christians a way out: simply sacrifice to the old Romans gods and happily go on your way! Inevitably many Christians, including pastors and bishops, made the sacrifices and renounced their faith in Christ. After a few years, however, the government began to permit Christianity. Many of those who had renounced their faith came back to church as if nothing had happened.

Things came to a boil quickly! Those who had not renounced their face viewed these returnees as traitors, apostates, and turncoats. Question rose: could churches accept these people back? Did they have to be baptized again? What if your minister had renounced the faith – did you have to be rebaptized? It was a question of identity: is the church a museum of saints, or a hospital for sinners?

These questions led to nasty church splits and controversies, but they forced those early Christians to acknowledge that the Christian life is one fundamentally rooted in the forgiveness of sins. Sins and screw-ups, failures and faults, do not disqualify you from following Jesus. If they did, every church ought to be empty! We are), 234.community of imperfect people called to be patient and understanding with one another. As St. Augustine put it, "We should never despair of anyone at all." Including yourself!


