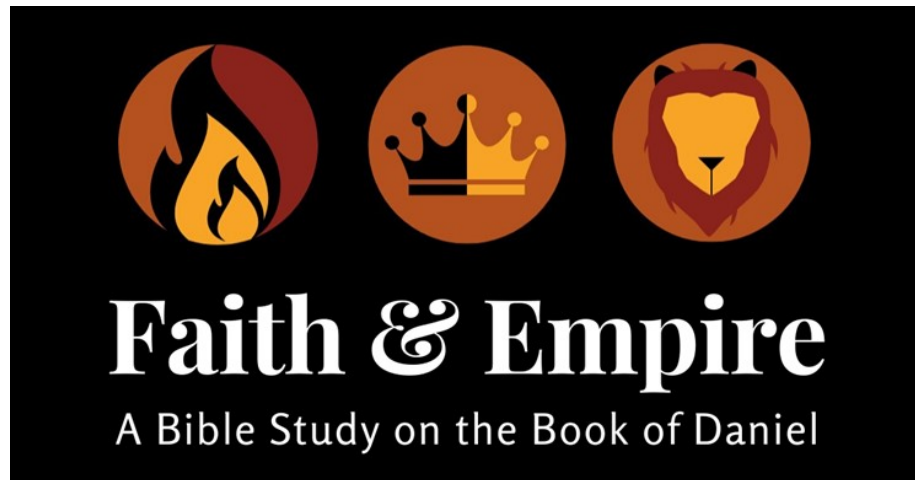

Even though our culture is increasingly secular, people still want to hear from God. In my years as a pastor I've heard people say that God spoke to them in dreams, that seeing a cardinal as a loved-one died was a message from God, that God speaks to them by sending pennys on the pavement, and that God "told" someone to break-up with his girlfriend. "Wow," I think. "How come God doesn't speak like that to me?"

Unlike dreams, birds, pennys, and feelings, wouldn't it be even better if God spoke clearly, authoritatively and certainly? I don't know about you, but I find a lot of change in the street – how do I know if it's a message from God or just some careless kid?

While God could communicate any way he'd like, the ordinary way he speaks is through a book. As Christians, we hold that God worked through the agency of the many different biblical authors to speak his Word. This is why Christians are always on about reading the Bible: it's the one place we consistently and clearly hear God's voice. Peter writes, "For no prophecy was ever produced by the will of man, but men spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit" (1 Pe 1:21). Paul adds, "All Scripture is breathed out by God" (2 Tim 3:16). In the Bible, we find many different writings, but one God speaking through them all.

Wouldn't it be amazing to hear from God? As summer begins and schedules change, keep reading your Bible!
