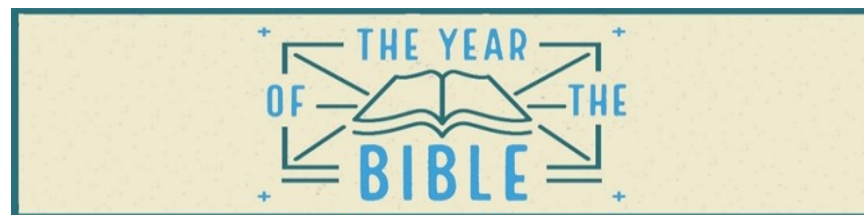

Pastor's Pen



A stomach condition has meant much less coffee in my life – and *more herbal tea*. The thing about herbal tea is that it can't be rushed. You drop in the bag and let it steep, the color and flavor slowly spreading from the leaves into the water. One type calls for *eight minutes* of steeping! While coffee may be all about speed, energy, and activity, herbal tea can't be rushed. Let it sit. Let it rest. After a time the hot water takes on some of the qualities of the leaves. The color, flavor, scent, and even texture is enhanced. It's transformed.

Paul reminds us that *our* transformation as Christians begins with our minds: "Be transformed by the renewal of your minds" (Romans 12:2). Our ingrained mental habits and internal-dialogues are self-reinforcing. What we focus on changes the *way* we think. So one way God transforms us is by filling our minds *with his thoughts*: the scripture.

Bible reading can at times leave us dry, bored, or confused. We wonder, "What's the point of reading this?" But consistent Bible study bears *permeates* our minds, *colors* our thinking, *transforms* our minds as our thought-patterns are molded by God's thoughts.

Hearing a scripture on Sunday is like a quick dip into the hot water. Attending a study is another. Yet God invites us to let his word soak daily in our minds, "I remember the days of long ago; I meditate on all your works and consider what your hands have done" (Ps 143:5).

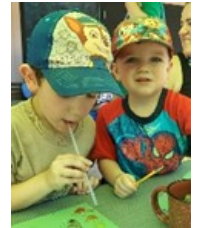
